Livestock Auction

All Large Livestock will be sold by the pound.

MAXIMUM PAY WEIGHTS

Swine 250 lbs. Sheep 150 lbs.

Steers 1300 lbs. Goats 105 lbs.

This is a **TERMINAL SALE** there will be **NO LIVE PICK-UP!**
Market prices for resale will be posted day of sale.

All Supreme Champion Small Livestock (Turkeys, Rabbit Meat Pens, and Broiler Meat Pens) will be sold by the head.

Supreme Champion Small Livestock will be processed, and must be picked up at the Fair Administration Office May 24 or 25. Any Animal not picked up will be donated to the local Foodbank.

Buyers Breakfast

Buyers will receive 2 tickets to the Buyers Breakfast at the Registration Desk when picking up Buyer Number

Decisions to make as a Buyer!

Resale

If you wish to support a young exhibitor by purchasing an animal but you do not want the animal, you mark **resale** on the sales invoice. With this method, you as the buyer will pay the difference between the price you bid and the market value of the animal on the day of the sale (market prices will be posted). You will not receive any meat nor will you take delivery of the animal.

**The ONLY Animals available for Resale are:
Swine, Market Beef, Goats, and Sheep.**

Process

If you wish the fair to ship your purchased animal to a processing plant to be processed for your own use, you will mark **process** on the sales invoice. After processing, carcasses will be delivered to the meat locker specified for each specie, for cut and wrap. It is imperative that **you** contact the meat locker for your preference of cut and wrap, and that **you** pick up your meat as soon as possible. Meat not picked up in a timely manner will be donated to the local Foodbank.

**The ONLY Animals available for Processing are:
Turkeys, Rabbits, Chickens, Swine, Steers, Goats, and Sheep.**

Payment Information

Payment is encouraged the day of the Auction. Payments can be made by Check, Cash, Visa or MasterCard. Buyers will be invoiced after the Fair. After 30-days 1.5% interest will be assessed monthly on monies owed. Any Payments not received after 60 days will be sent to Collections.

Turkeys, Chickens & Rabbits

You will receive whole turkey, chickens or rabbits and must be picked up at the Fair Administration Office on May 24 or 25.

As the Buyer it is your responsibility to communicate with the local processor regarding your choice of cut and wrap.
